By working alongside teams across NHG, including technology teams, you will help drive improvements and support staff as they take on new responsibilities. Your work will have a direct impact on our residents in our homes.

How you'll do it

Role accountabilities and top line deliverables:

- Work as a trusted partner to help teams become more data driven.
- Nurture relationships and influence both within and outside the sector.
- Work with operational businesses to understand their priorities and develop the annual programme of data governance work ensuring engagement and communications with the teams.
- Provide technical and subject matter expertise on reports and data sources, write and interpret SQL reports that deliver intelligence to the operational teams.
- Support NHG's approach to data governance, including writing standards and principles, and managing data governance frameworks.

- Develop and deliver data governance/quality dashboards and automate NHG's KPI framework.
- Managing defining requirements of Board and EB level dashboards and championing their delivery.
- Work with IT to maintain accurate data sources.
- Work to support the businesses in making the most of their data, working closely with them to produce ad-hoc reporting requests, as required.
- Managing the rules and technical skill set required to establish the data governance framework in place.
- Supporting ensuring NHG has relevant policies and processes around data ethics to maximise the value of our data and protects NHGs from risk.
- Identify new requirements and ensure new products support data governance work.
- Ensure that you follow and keep up to date with all relevant Notting Hill Genesis and statutory policies and related procedures including health and safety and financial regulations.
